Understanding The Medicaid Process

There are two steps to be eligible for Medicaid:

- (1) Pre-Admission Evaluation Form (PAE). A PAE Form must be completed by the physician or RN. The PAE Form can be provided by the facility upon request. Once completed the application must be faxed or mailed to the TennCare Long-Term Care Division in Nashville. The approval process/time period usually takes 1-2 weeks. The family representative will be notified by mail of the decision. If denied, you have 30 days to appeal.
- (2) Financial Approval. Medicaid eligible residents are responsible for paying the facility a patient liability upon move-in. A financial form in the Medicaid packet is used to determine the monthly amount to be collected by the facility. Factors such as Social Security income, additional pension/retirement income, monthly insurance premiums, marital status and whether spouse lives at home must be considered in this determination. Upon admission, the Social Services Director of Ave Maria will assist the applicant in processing the financial application through the Department of Human Services (DHS).

The Department of Human Services requires the following documents to process the financial application. For assistance, you can contact the DHS at 320-7200.

Copy of:

- Social Security card or letter from SSA certifying the number
- Medicare card or letter certifying the number, type of coverage from hospital/medical benefits and effective date
- Spouse's Social Security card
- Marriage license or divorce decree, if available
- Three (3) most recent bank statements (checking and saving)
- All insurance policies such as (1) hospital/medical and proof of payment from health insurance, (2) disability, (3) life or statement from the insurance company of the face or cash value, (4) burial (statement from the insurance company or agency indicating face value of policy or policies.
- Burial plot(s) or prepaid funeral arrangements
- City and County property tax receipts
- Settlement sheet from any property that has been transferred within the last 36 months
- Deeds and legal papers to all property you own or have interest in
- Medicaid card, if applicable
- Birth certificate or proof of age
- List of other assets and their value
- Title to automobile or bill of sale and motor vehicle registration
- Current rent receipt on all rental property
- Proof of: (1) earnings/income (SS, retirement, pension checks, etc.), (2) spouse's earnings, (3) spouse's death (if applicable), (4) cash value of bonds, stock certificates or other assets



Medical Services

Each resident will be followed by the physician of their choice. Ed Hines III, M.D., serves as Medical Director.

The podiatrist visits Ave Maria on a monthly basis to provide podiatry services. The nursing staff generally schedules podiatry services on a quarterly basis. These services are billed after each visit.

Dental Services such as teeth cleaning and denture repair are available. The Social Services Director schedules all dental appointments. There are fees assessed for these services. The Social Services Director can arrange on-site appointments as needed for basic optometry and audiology testing.

The facility offers pharmacy services. Information is available if needed.

Hospice Care is available when (1) the resident and family request the service, (2) the resident's doctor and the hospice medical director certify that the resident has a limited life expectancy of approximately six months or less if the terminal illness runs its normal course, and (3) the resident and family understand that the hospice concept of care is palliative and not curative in its goals.

Psychological and psychiatric consultations can be arranged if needed.
